- March. 2016 : Adoption of the national **Road map for INDC's and Paris Agreement** implementation
- Oct. 2016 : Rattification of the Paris Agreement
- Dec. 2016 : Adoption of the **national framework on transparency (NFT)** to follow-up the NDC's implementation actions.





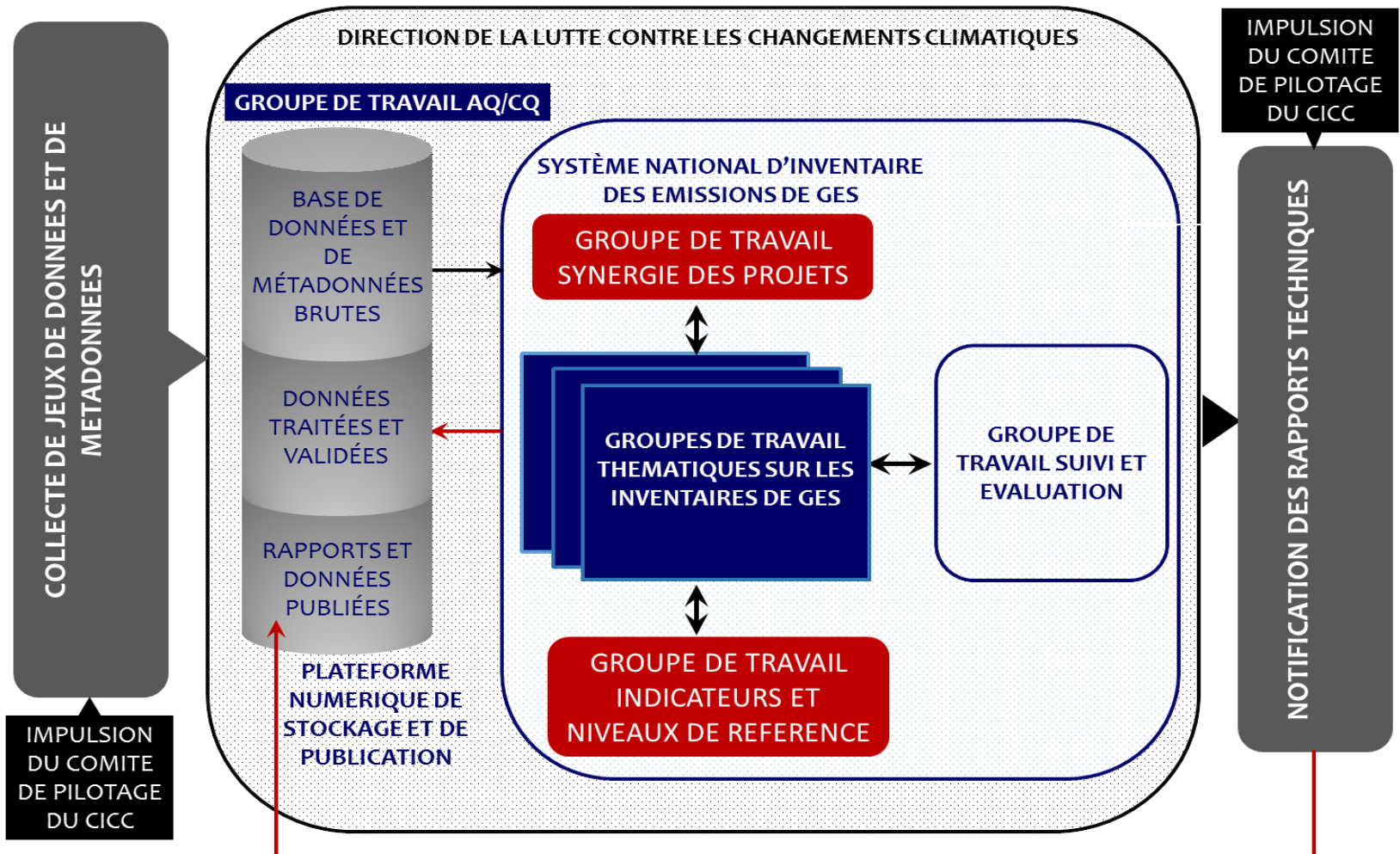
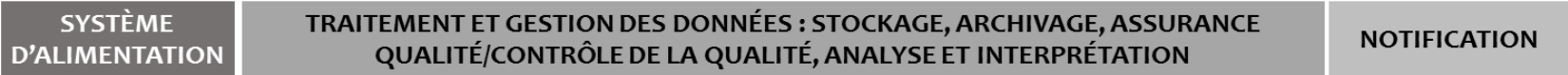
Objectives of our NFT

- Supporting **capacity building of all national stakeholders** ;
- Creating awareness within **national institutions** responsible for data collection, inventory compiling and inventory archiving ;
- Identify different options in order to increase our ambitions for future NDC.

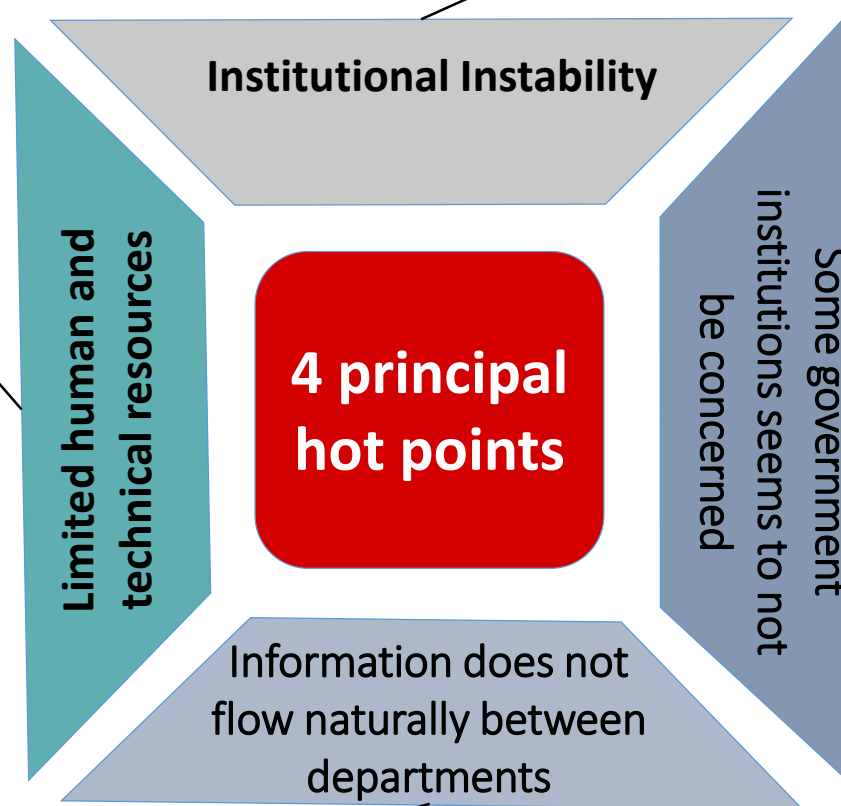




Challenges and Responses

A strong legislative framework, notably fed by inter-ministerial regulatory texts (CICC)

- Dev. of a national capacity-building plan
- Mobilization of financial resources for IT and measurements equipments
